

# STADIUM/START/EXCHANGE


- Please have athletes enter the stadium in the same way
- No timing chips
- Start will be from a 5 lane chevron grid
- ➤ Racer position in the grid will be based on total points for all athletes on official teams. In case of a tie, team with the highest point athlete wins
- Unofficial teams and teams without points will be random draw at the back of the grid
- Some races will start 1 minute apart. Please have your athletes to the start in plenty of time to load the grid
- The exchange zone will be on the athletes' right side as they approach, lap lane for through traffic will be on their left
- Athletes MUST exit the exchange zone to their right into stadium to avoid contact with athletes on a lap to their left

# STADIUM/START/EXCHANGE

- Clothing drop
- Red dye will mark the start and finish of the exchange
- The area inside the stadium adjacent to the exchange zone is for athletes only
- ➤ Have a radio on the backstretch to call in your athletes to the exchange zone Athletes can only stand in the exchange zone when they are preparing to exchange
- > No waxing inside the stadium
- ➤ Waxing may happen in your cabins or along that portion of the finish lanes there will be a marshalled area at the start of the finish corridor to allow wax techs to cross and bring in skis
- > This is to allow athletes safe room to warm up






#### Junior B/G and Juvenile B/G 3 x (2 X 2.5)





#### Midget B/G $3 \times (2 \times 1 \text{Km})$






# **Ski Wax Testing**

- No skiing backwards on course.








### Bantam/PeeWee B/G 3 x 1 km






# **ATOMS B/G 500**
